New at the Library:

Library Facelift: We expect the renovation of the 2nd floor to be completed in February. Carpet will be installed the first week of the month and doors will follow. The Center for Excellence in Teaching and Learning and Fine Arts Institute will then move in. The new furnishings and library collections will arrive later. The completed 2nd floor will include the Center for Excellence in Teaching and Learning, the Fine Arts Institute, the Center for Interpersonal Studies through Film and Literature, the CETL classroom (DBL 214), the CETL seminar room (DBL 215), the Seminary Librarian, a faculty carrel, the OCU Film Institute collection, and the library's religion collection (200s).

THE LIBRARY CATALOG PART 1

The library catalog is a record of all items that are owned by the library, including all of our books, print journals, recordings, films, electronic books and government documents. The SEARCH THE LIBRARY CATALOG box on the Dulaney-Browne Library home page provides a simple keyword search of the library catalog. Using the drop down list next to the search box you can change the search to Title, Author, Journal Title, Subject or Call Number.

If you would like to do a

more precise search of catalog click the "search more books" link under the search box and click the "Dulaney-Browne Library Catalog link. This will take you to a page that offers a Basic Search option, an Advanced Search option and a Course Reserve Locations option. Basic Search is the same as the search from the library home page with an added option to refine your search by collection or location. Advanced Search lets you select several search options

from drop down menus on the right side of the page. You can also combine search terms and categories using the Boolean operator options (AND, OR and NOT) on the page. Course Reserve Locations lets you check to see if your professor has any items on reserve

for your class. Course Reserve can be searched by the instructor's name, the department name or the class name. A successful search in the library catalog will retrieve a list of one or more titles. This list will tell you the call number for each item, its location in the library and the date it was published. By clicking on

a specific item you can get more information about the item, such as subject headings, sometimes tables of contents, bibliography notes and publisher information. The catalog will also tell you if an item is currently on the shelf or if it is checked out and when it is due back. The status is available on both the titles and item screens.
