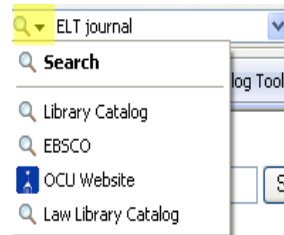
LIBRARY TOOLBAR

Download the Dulaney-Browne Library toolbar today! The new toolbar will allow you to search Google, the library catalog, EBSCOhost, OCU's website, and the law library's catalog all at once. You can download the new toolbar at <http://librarycatalog.ourtoolbar.com> (see picture on page 2, below the calendar.) Once the toolbar is installed it will open inside the top of your internet browser so you can quickly search any time.

Choosing Searches: You can choose to search just one catalog or database

by using the drop-down menu inside the search box.

Simply choose which



search you want to perform (EBSCO, OCU Website, etc...) and type in your search terms.

Search Results: Your initial search results will be from Google. A list of available searches will appear in blue along the

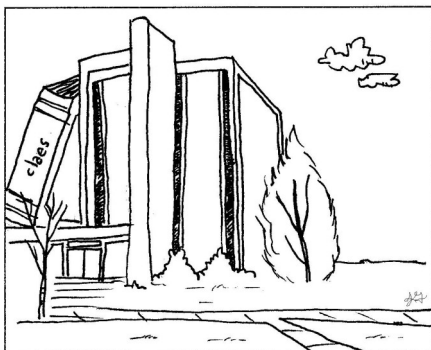

top of your results. Click any of the options, such as “library catalog” to view the results. (see picture of links at the end of this article.)

Sample Search: Pretend you are looking for the ELT Journal (English Language Teaching Journal), and you type it in the library toolbar

search box. The Google results will direct you to the homepage for the journal where you can find out pricing and background information about the journal. If you click on “Library Catalog” you will be able to find out what issues the library owns. The “EBSCO” link will give you articles from the journal. The “OCU Website” link will have

results about the TESOL program as well as a link to one of the library’s research guides for TESOL.
