New at the Library:

Library Facelift: 1st floor renovations begin May 12, 2008. The library will remain open, but some services will be moved. You will find a corridor from the front doors to the elevators on the 1st floor. A temporary circulation desk will allow you to check out and return materials. The 2nd floor will include the reference collection, reference librarian, and new media collection. Print periodicals will be in the basement. Ask at the circulation desk to access these materials. Microfilm and microfiche periodicals will be on the 4th floor. Government Documents microfiche will be on the 3rd floor. Copiers/printers will be on the 2nd and 5th floors and extra computers will be added to the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th floors.

THE LIBRARY CATALOG PART 3

Part 1 of this article introduced the basic search. Part 2 explained what type of results to expect and part 3 will explain how you can login to the catalog to renew items, save searches, and more.

Logging in: To log in to the library catalog you need to access the basic search page. You can do this in two ways: clicking on the search button located on the library's homepage without entering a search or by clicking on the "search online resources" and clicking the library catalog link (1st link on the page.) Once you have accessed the basic search page click the

"login" button at the top of the page. You will be prompted for you OCU student ID number and your last name. If the login is successful, you will be taken back to the search page. If you have trouble, ask for help at the circulation desk or call 208-5068.

Renew items online: Once you are logged in you can view all items you have checked out by clicking on the "patron" button at the top of the page. At the very top of the page you will see you contact information. Scroll down and you will see a listing of all items you have

checked out and their due dates. You can only renew items that are **NOT** overdue. To renew an item check the box to the left of the title (the renew? column) and scroll to the bottom of the list and click the “renew items button.” If you encounter problems contact the circulation desk and we can manually renew the items for you.

Save items to your bookbag: Saving items to your bookbag allows you to do searches from home and then easily lookup the call number and location of items once you are physically in the library. It is also a good place to keep electronic books so you can access them quickly from any computer. To place items in your bookbag, login to the catalog and perform a search. Check

the box to the left of all titles you want to save and scroll down to the bottom of the page. Click on the “save to bookbag button,” which is the last button on the page. To access these titles from another computer, login to the catalog and click the “bookbag” button at the top of the page.

Save searches: You can also save searches. Login to the catalog, perform a search, scroll to the bottom of the

screen and click the “save search query button.” Click on the “saved searches” button to access these searches later. For more information contact us at 208-5068.
