## PSYCHOLOGY RESEARCH GUIDE

The psychology research guide is designed to help you find and evaluate resources available online and in print. The full guide is available at [www.okcu.edu/library/lib45.aspx](http://www.okcu.edu/library/lib45.aspx)

PsycInfo, PsycARTICLES, Medline, and Academic Search Complete are some of the best EBSCOhost databases for finding peer-reviewed articles on psychology. See also the Directory of Open Access Journals ([www.doaj.org](http://www.doaj.org)) for more online articles. An excellent selection of online full-text and print journals covering psychology can be found at

the E-Journal Portal's (<http://qv3dr7cw3h.search.serialsolutions.com/>) Subject Headings in Social Sciences. Please note that the Dulaney-Browne Library may have some years of its psychology journals in the databases, in print on the shelves, and/or in microfiche. See the online guide for further listings of major psychology periodicals.

**Books:** To find print books and ebooks held by our library, go to the online catalog (<http://library.okcu.edu/catalog>) and select "Subject" from the drop-down menu, then type a subject of your choice into the

search-box; in the search results, click on the subject heading for a list of titles. (Note: If you don't know the exact subject heading for your topic, click on "Search more books," then "Catalog" and select "Advanced Search"; type your topic words into the first search-box and drop-down "Subject.") See the online guide for examples.

Many psychology books in Dulaney-Browne Library are shelved in the classification numbers 150-158.9 (psychology) as well as 362.2 and 616.89 (mental disorders) in the reference area on the first floor and on the third floor. To find books in
