New at the Library:

Furniture Sale Continues: The library furniture sale will continue until all furniture not needed after the renovation of the 5th floor is sold or the demolition begins. Furniture will be on the 5th floor and clearly marked with the price. New furniture is added periodically. Current items include library study tables, chairs and individual carrels, desks, office equipment, and a few mid-century collectibles (Bertoia diamond chairs and a table). Due to various logistical concerns we cannot hold furniture for later pickup, so you will need to come prepared to pay for and remove your furniture immediately.

New Music Librarian: Bonnie Elizabeth (Beth) Fleming joined the library staff as music librarian in August. Her new office inside the Leichter Listening Library is currently under construction. She will also be spending time in the Dulaney-Browne Library helping with general reference and using a temporary office space.

Ebsco and JSTOR Training: The library staff will offer two dates for learning more about changes and special features available from the library's two major database vendors, Ebsco and JSTOR. The first session will be Thursday, September 2nd at 3:00 p.m. The second session will be Friday, September 17th at noon. Both sessions will be held in the library computer lab to provide opportunities for hands-on practice with new features including JSTOR's extended indexing of newer titles and those not included in our subscriptions and Ebsco's new relevancy sort. The sessions will also cover advanced features such as citation analysis, alert services, saving searches, and setting up links to articles in Desire 2 Learn.

New Databases: The library added *Computers and Applied Sciences Complete* and *SPORT Discus* to its collection of EBSCOhost databases in August.

Library Widget

The library has a new research tool. It is a widget that contains a search box for the library's catalog and two of our most popular databases; Academic Search Complete and JSTOR. The widget also contains quick links to research guides, a listing of all our databases, our journals list, and library hours. Finally, the widget contains information on how to quickly contact a librarian for help both via email and phone. The widget can be added to your personal website or your course website (D2L) by just copying and pasting some HTML code. You can
