When you are selected as a Clara Luper Scholarship Recipient we will confirm your eligibility for all general OCU scholarships; we will confirm your eligibility for available aid from outside sources based upon evaluation of your completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) including state and federal aid; we will confirm you tribal and/or other outside need or talent based scholarships, and then we will complete your scholarship package and work with you to fully understand what the final costs to you, if any, will be for attending Oklahoma City University.**
