# CONCENTRATION IN ACCOUNTING

Oklahoma City University, through its School of Adult & Continuing Education in conjunction with the Meinders School of Business, is proud to introduce its newest degree program—the **B.S. in Professional Studies with a Concentration in Accounting**. Designed for students who desire a more focused degree than is offered by typical programs in General Business, the 30 credit hours of accounting courses are taught exclusively by faculty from Oklahoma City University's Meinders School of Business.

The School of Adult & Continuing Education's flexible general education program (area rather than specific course requirements) and liberal transfer credit policy (a maximum of 84 hours can be accepted) allow students whose original college experience was interrupted their best opportunity to complete their degrees from Oklahoma's oldest and most respected adult degree completion program. Oklahoma City University is consistently ranked in the top tier of master's level institutions in the Southwest region by *U.S. News & World Report's America's Best Colleges*. With more than 30 years of experience and 5,000 graduates, the School of Adult & Continuing Education has long been the leader in adult degree programs in the state of Oklahoma.

Programs in the School of Adult & Continuing Education are designed primarily to meet the needs of working adults over the age of 25 with 30-84 semester hours of prior college work and who are committed to achieving the goal of attaining the bachelor's degree. Day, evening (8-week and 16-week), weekend, and web-based classes are available.

The professional studies major with concentration in accounting totals 39 credit hours. Fifteen hours of professional studies major requirements, six hours of which are accounting courses, are supplemented by an additional 24 upper-division hours of accounting courses. Students must complete the School of Adult & Continuing Education's general education program and additional elective hours may be required to complete the minimum 124 credit hours required for graduation.

This degree meets all course requirements for admission to Oklahoma City University's Master of Science in Accounting degree program.
