To determine your summer financial aid award in a timely manner, we need to receive your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), your Summer 2009 Financial Aid Application, a copy of your summer enrollment, Student Data Form, and all other required documents by **April 12, 2009**. **Students who apply late may not have their funds at the beginning of the term.**

If you have not filed a 2009-2010 FAFSA, you must complete and submit the 2009-2010 FAFSA online at www.fafsa.ed.gov before we can process your 2009 summer application. You must also be enrolled in summer classes. Please do **NOT** submit the 2009 Summer Financial Aid Application **until you have enrolled in summer classes**.

Summer 2009 Aid Availability

NOTICE: We cannot estimate summer financial aid eligibility. You must wait to receive notification from our office to know if you are eligible for summer aid. Apply early if you need to know before you attend.

As you consider attending the Summer 2009 term, please be aware of the following information regarding financial aid eligibility and availability:

The following programs are available for the Summer 2009 term depending upon availability of funding.

- Federal Workstudy
- Federal Stafford Loans
- Federal Parent and Graduate PLUS Loans

Federal Stafford Loans are limited as follows:

- Freshmen may borrow up to \$3,500 in Federal Stafford Loans per year.
- Sophomores may borrow up to \$4,500 in Federal Stafford Loans per year.
- Junior and Seniors may borrow up to \$5,500 in Federal Stafford Loans per year.
- Graduate students may borrow up to \$20,500 in Federal Stafford Loans per year.

Students who are also applying for fall and spring financial aid will receive 1/3 of their eligibility in the summer, 1/3 in the fall, and 1/3 in the spring. Undergraduate students who are graduating in the summer will have their Stafford Loan eligibility prorated based on length of summer term and hours enrolled as prescribed by federal regulations.

Unsubsidized Stafford Loans- Independent undergraduate students and Graduate students may be eligible for a Federal Unsubsidized Stafford loan. Undergraduates may receive up to \$5,000 per year and Graduates may receive up to \$12,000 per year. Eligibility for this additional loan for summer depends on your summer cost of attendance as determined by the Office of Financial Aid.

Federal PLUS Loans- Graduate students and Parents of dependent undergraduate students may borrow a PLUS Loan to assist in paying for summer expenses.

I understand that I must notify the Office of Financial Aid of any enrollment changes, and these changes could cause a delay in receiving my financial aid.

I also understand that I will not know my summer aid eligibility until after my summer aid application is processed, and I receive an email award notification from the Oklahoma City University Office of Financial Aid. I am attaching a copy of my summer class schedule to this form. (A summer application that does not have a copy of enrollment attached will be discarded, and the applicant will be required to resubmit the form with the appropriate documentation.)
