



## The Undergraduate Research Scholarship Application

Oklahoma City University has a limited number of competitive academic scholarships available to high school seniors that is qualified to participate in the Undergraduate Research Program.

The Undergraduate Research Program is open for students who have proven research and academic skills from high school credentials.

Students are required to have a minimum ACT score of 27 in addition to a solid high school GPA and complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). A letter of recommendation is required to be considered for this prestigious scholarship award. **This award is not stackable with any other university scholarship.**

The Undergraduate Research Scholarship selection committee will assess multiple criteria, including but not limited to ACT/SAT score, grade point average, letter of recommendation from a teacher or mentor, community involvement and need. An interview will be scheduled with selected applications.

Scholarship application deadline is March 1, 2010 with notifications being made by March 31, 2010.
