



**The Great Plan Scholars Scholarship Application**

Each year, Oklahoma City University awards the prestigious Mary Ellen and George R. Randall Endowed Great Plan Scholarship to a graduating high school senior who intends to study pre-medicine, or major in science at Oklahoma City University. The scholarship is a competitive four-year scholarship covering tuition, basic room and board, and fees. Preference is given to students from Oklahoma or the Midwest.

The Great Plan Scholars Scholarship selection committee will assess multiple criteria, including but not limited to ACT/SAT score, grade point average, letter of recommendation from a teacher or mentor, community involvement, and need. An on-campus interview will be scheduled with selected applicants. **This award cannot be combined with any other university scholarships.**

Priority scholarship application deadline is March 1, annually, with notifications being made by March 31, annually.
