## PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARS PROGRAM APPLICATION

This innovative and challenging academic program will be awarded to high school seniors from the state of Oklahoma attending Oklahoma City University as full-time undergraduate students in the Meinders School of Business. This program is coordinated by Meinders School of Business faculty in conjunction with designated Chesapeake Energy Inc. representatives. The OCU president will conduct regular meetings with distinguished national and international guest speakers, and scholarship recipients will be included. The recipients could receive up to a \$100,000 (\$25,000 scholarship for tuition per year for four years) or may stack this award with other awards up to the cost of tuition.

### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Full-time freshman students in the Meinders School of Business majoring in the following areas: finance, economics, accounting, marketing, business administration, sports business, computer science, not-for-profit business, or information technology.
- Must have a minimum unweighted GPA of 3.5 and 26 on the ACT. Applicants must also graduate from an Oklahoma High School. A select number of out-of-state candidates may be reviewed each year.
- Complete and submit the OCU application for admission, Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA, OCU's School Code 003166) and other pertinent information related to the admissions process. Application for the scholarship will not be reviewed until the student has been admitted to the university and submitted their FAFSA.

### QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Selection for admission to the Chesapeake Presidential Scholarship program is limited. Students are encouraged to apply early to improve selection opportunities.
- Complete the Chesapeake Presidential Scholars application and turn in for review by the Scholarship Selection Committee by February 1st, 2011. Submit your completed application to the Office of Admissions at 2501 N. Blackwelder Ave. Oklahoma City, OK 73106.
- An interview will be scheduled by the committee after reviewing applicants and all decisions will be made no later than March 31st, 2011.
- Must maintain a 3.5 in OCU coursework.
