### **Arbitration – Decisions, Agreements and Cases**

Most parties enter arbitration to avoid the publication the final resolution of their dispute. However, parties may consent to have an arbitration decision published. The decisions of labor arbitrations are frequently published and sources are discussed in the section "Labor and Employment Arbitration - Cases and Decisions." Specifically see Chapter 11 "Precedential Value of Arbitral Awards" in *How Arbitration Works*. Case law relating to arbitration agreements is also relevant.

### **Searching for Articles**

The OHIO STATE JOURNAL ON DISPUTE RESOLUTION publishes an annual bibliography of articles usually in the Fall or Summer issue. Fall 2005 v20 i4 p1063-1242

Thomas H. Oehmke's *Commercial Arbitration* has a list of references to articles and books at the beginning of some sections.

LexisNexis library of ADR law review articles (LAWREV;ADRMLR). Keep in mind that this database contains the full text of articles but generally only includes articles after 1980. It is also wise to search in the library including all law review articles (LAWREV).

Westlaw lists specific journals at its ADR page or you can search in all journals and law reviews in the database (TP-ALL).

*Current Law Index* (indexes by title, author, and subject) (1980 – present) Originally introduced because the *Index to Legal Periodicals* was not covering all periodicals and practice resources. It is similar to the *Index to Legal Periodicals* but it includes separate subject and author/title indexes. Available electronically in the LegalTrac database. A subject search for "Dispute Resolution" will retrieve relevant articles which can be browsed or narrowed by subdivision. Also available in the Westlaw database (LRI).

*Index to Legal Periodicals* (one index combining title, author and subject) (1886 – present) and online from 1981 – present. Also accessible from the Lexis library (LAWREV;ILP) and the Westlaw database (ILP). To view articles organized by subject, search the thesaurus search function for the term "Dispute Resolution."

### **International Commercial Arbitration - World Trade Organization**

The General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade (GATT) was established to create binding tariff concessions and to liberalize trade between member nations. Twenty three countries signed the GATT in 1947. Under the GATT disputes were settled by panel decisions. At the Uruguay Rounds in 1994, GATT member nations created the World Trade Organization (WTO) and strengthened the dispute settlement process. After the Uruguay Rounds disputes were settled by dispute settlement decisions.
