Hours: Summer hours began May 10, 2009. We will be closing at 9pm instead of Midnight Sunday—Thursdays. On Fridays we will only be open from 8am-5pm and closed on Saturdays.

Music Library Summer Hours:

The music library will be closed for the summer starting Saturday May 8, 2010. If you need an item from the music library please request it through the catalog using the “Get it; 2 Days” form. Log into the online catalog, search for the item you want, click the request forms link on the right, and then choose the “Get it; 2 Days” form and submit it.

Archives Reading Room: The reading room will be closed Friday thru Sunday during the summer. You can make an appointment by contacting the Archivist, Christina Wolf at 208-5919 or cwolf@okcu.edu. Normal hours are Monday thru Thursday from 9am—2pm.

5th Floor Renovation: Renovation of the 5th floor is scheduled to begin in October, but regular library visitors will begin to see changes in preparation of the move starting in May. The first major change will be the installation of additional shelving on the 4th floor to accommodate the library collections from the 5th floor. When this is complete, library staff members will begin the process of shifting books on the 4th floor to make room for the 5th floor collections.

LIBRARY TOOLBAR

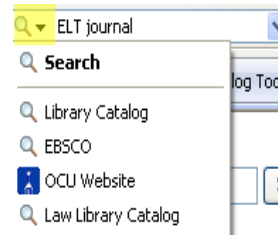


Download the Dulaney-Browne Library toolbar today! The new toolbar will allow you to search Google, the library catalog, EBSCOhost, OCU’s website, and the law library’s catalog all at once. You can download the new toolbar at <http://librarycatalog.ourtoolbar.com> (see picture on page 2, below the calendar.) Once the toolbar is installed it will open inside the top of your internet browser so you can quickly search any time.

Choosing Searches: You can choose to search just one catalog or database by using the drop-down

menu inside the search box.

Simply choose which



search you want to perform (EBSCO, OCU Website, etc...) and type in your search terms.

Search Results: Your initial search results will be from Google. A list of available searches will appear in blue along the top of your results. Click

any of the options, such as “library catalog” to view the results. (see picture of links at the end of this article.)

Sample Search: Pretend you are looking for the ELT Journal (English Language Teaching Journal), and you type it in the library toolbar search box. The Google results will direct you to the homepage for the journal where you can find out pricing and background information about the journal. If you click on “Library Catalog” you will be able to find out what issues the library owns. The

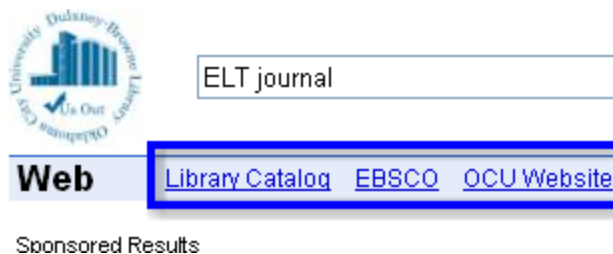
MUSIC LISTENING LIBRARY
