**Travel:**

Located at the crossroads of I-35, I-40 and I-44, Oklahoma City is easy to reach by car. Will Rogers World Airport also offers nonstop air service to 26 destinations in the U.S., including west and east coast cities. Amtrak service is available via The Heartland Flyer which makes daily runs to Oklahoma City from Fort Worth, Texas.

**Hotel Information:**

The Waterford Marriott ([www.marriott.com/hotels/travel/okcwa-waterford-marriott](http://www.marriott.com/hotels/travel/okcwa-waterford-marriott)) has reserved a limited number of rooms for conference attendees at a reduced rate of \$107 per night, plus applicable state and local taxes.
