The Miss America Organization's Amazing Legacy at Oklahoma City University

*I*n 2006, Oklahoma City University's relationship with the Miss America Organization will turn fifty. LaDonna Kramer Meinders (See sidebar, page 6.) became Miss Oklahoma 1956 while at OCU. Since then, our students have won thirty more state and three national titles.

JUNE'S MISS OKLAHOMA COMPETITION was typical. Six OCU students participated: **Chelsea Cain**, dance management freshman from Duncan; **Jessica Eckert**, mass communications sophomore from Claremore; **Leah Ledbetter**, mass communications senior from Oklahoma City;

Brooke Haley, mass communications senior from Pryor; **Kelley Scott**, accounting master student from Claremore; and **Sarah Reed**, dance freshman from Edmond. **Scott** was crowned Miss Oklahoma 2003. (See interview, p. 8.) **Haley** made the top five.

Not just another pretty face

Miss America Pageant judges look for an obvious commitment to community service, academic achievement, and talent as a spokesperson. Final scoring is based on interview (40 percent), talent (30 percent), and appearance (30 percent).

The non-profit Miss America Organization is the world's largest single source of scholarship funds for young women. This year, it offered more than \$30 million in scholarships. OCU provided the 2003 Miss Oklahoma Pageant over \$53,000 in tuition college scholarships.

In 1989, the Miss America Organization founded the platform concept. Competitors at all levels must address nationally relevant issues. It is cliché to lampoon the use they would make of their titles, but a quick glance at the list of causes for which Miss OCUs have volunteered is impressive: Alzheimer's awareness, arts in education, Big Brothers-Big Sisters, birth defects (March of Dimes), breast cancer awareness, dance therapy (Chance to Dance), drunk driving, eating disorders, fire safety and awareness, and mentoring in the arts and education. Miss OCU 2003, **Leah Ledbetter**, chose after school programs.

One can only get so far in this life on looks.

It takes other qualities – determination, intelligence, social skills, talent, spiritual growth – to continue making a difference in your community years, even decades, after initial success. In June, the university relations department ran an ad in the Miss Oklahoma program booklet to encourage the six OCU students competing. Since then, we have received several handwritten thank-you notes. Whatever else may be said about pageant participants, they are polite. And, in this world, that counts for a lot. **FM**

La Donna Meinders grew up on a farm near Loyal, Okla. She is an accomplished musician and private instructor. She and **Ellen Jayne Wheeler**, '67 Master of Arts in Teaching and former OCU music instructor, had a successful duo piano concert career; its highlight came in 1976, when they performed at the Kennedy Center as part of the national bicentennial celebration.

Meinders is active in the Societies of Oklahoma City University and received the 1995 Kirkpatrick-Petree Opera and Music Theater Award. She has authored two books: *Leaves in the Wind* and *Angel Hugs*.

The university's Kramer School of Nursing is named for her parents, Mr. and Mrs. E.J. Kramer. **LaDonna Meinders** and her husband, university Trustee **Dr. Herman Meinders**, '89 honorary Doctor of Commercial Science, live in Oklahoma City.

"It opens doors for me to this day. People still get a hoot out of meeting 'Miss Oklahoma.' I spent a great deal of time in Governor Gary's office and got to serve as an honorary member of the Oklahoma Golden Jubilee Board. The one great thing it did for me was build my confidence and public speaking ability.

"I'm very pleased at the focus on community service, which wasn't a requirement when I competed. I would have chosen making the fine arts accessible to everyone – particularly school children. As a child, I spent eleven years in a very small, rural school. We didn't get much exposure to things like classical music, and I think everyone should." **FM**

Third generation Oklahoman **Jane Jayroe Gamble** is a native of the small, western town of Laverne.

Jane was a prime time news anchor for sixteen years, receiving several national awards, including being the first female named Outstanding News Personality in the Dallas television market. She also co-hosted a weekly statewide show, *Discover Oklahoma*. She was the first spokesperson for the Oklahoma Health Center and vice president of the Presbyterian Health Foundation. She has also served as cabinet secretary for tourism and recreation and executive director of the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department. She was the first woman elected chair of the Oklahoma Academy for State Goals, serves on the boards of OCU and the Oklahoma Health Center Foundation, and has received four gubernatorial appointments.

A member of the United Methodist Church of the Servant in Oklahoma City, Jane has served in numerous leadership and teaching positions.

What is the most exciting opportunity you received as Miss America?

The title and the experience gave me the confidence to succeed professionally. When I started in TV broadcasting, there were no women in the field except Barbara Walters. I had worked part-time in the journalism department as a work/study student and enjoyed it. I started in television in Oklahoma City. There were tons of job offers in other markets, but I wasn't interested until I was contacted by the Dallas/Ft. Worth station. It wasn't clear across the country and it was a top-ten TV market. I am very proud of the work I did there, and I was hired for my news experience, not because I had been Miss America.

What advice would you give today's journalism students?

Have a well-rounded skill set, and good writing is essential. Know how to be a producer and be willing to do whatever is needed in the newsroom to learn a skill; you must know as much as possible about how a broadcast is put together.

Do you still sing publicly?

Not very often, other than at church as an offering. When you've been professionally trained, you have a pretty high standard for public performance. I did perform at the dome dedication.

Did OCU's previous title holders influence you at all?

Kay Creed (Miss Oklahoma 1961) and Janie Zerger (Miss Oklahoma City 1965) were both Surrey Singers when I came to OCU as a freshman in 1965. They made an impression on me.


Is there a down side to the Miss America title?

When you have a title, people hold preconceptions about you. For example, when KXAS (now KNBC) hired me, the headline in the paper read, "KXAS Hires Barbie Doll." Whatever people think, there's no denying the women who make it to the Miss America Pageant are very successful.

Who were your favorite OCU professors?

Nancy Apgar, Ray Luke, Robert Laughlin, Inez Silberg – the entire music faculty; they really made me stretch and be the best I could be. At that time, the school had an opera orientation. I wanted to do musical theater and they knew I wouldn't be a serious opera singer, but I was treated seriously anyway.

What would you like to say to the OCU community?

I am so thankful I came to OCU. It has provided me with the resources to do so much more than I ever thought I could. In so many ways, we are the sum of investments other people have made in us.

Kelley Scott

Kelley Scott has one year remaining in the five-year Master of Science in Accounting program at the Meinders School of Business.

What is your most exciting opportunity as Miss Oklahoma so far?

The Oklahoma Health Department asked me to be spokesperson for Walk This Way, which helps communities assess their number one health concerns and identify steps to address them. I get to do public service announcements and will have a perfect opportunity to talk to people about KIX Klub. *KIX Klub (Kids into Exercise) is Scott's program to encourage children to exercise their hearts.*

She is concerned that most children's activity today revolves around technology and sedentary pastimes.

It's hard enough to motivate adults. How do you get kids away from the Game Cube?

You have to make it fun and not a chore. Each child is different. Some will be passionate about sports, like I was – and have parents who expose them to physical activity for fun. I have a crown and that gets their attention, but I can dribble a basketball and crabwalk with them, so they know I'm a real person. They think it's cool Miss Oklahoma plays basketball. Children are vulnerable when it comes to self-esteem, so the most important part of talking to them about exercise is to *not* make it about weight or looks. The heart is a muscle and needs to be worked out like any other muscle, but the consequences of not exercising it are a little more dramatic. They understand it when I put it in those terms.

You transferred here from OU because of the scholarship. How has OCU affected you?

Oklahoma City University is absolutely the best thing academically that has happened to me. The personal attention you get is invaluable. Attending here allowed me to pursue accounting, for example. I wasn't always the smartest student in my business classes, but the amount of confidence and motivation I got from my professors made me willing to keep at it. All of my professors knew me and understood my desire to earn the degree. The most obvious thing is: you know you are cared for, that the people here have your best interests at heart. I don't think I'd come back to visit, like today, and go to lunch with a favorite professor if I had studied somewhere else. It's a different kind of atmosphere, and I think that attitude is contagious. Being cared for inspires you to reach out and help others yourself.

Lunch with your favorite professor... Who is that, and why?

Dr. Barbara McCain. I took her Business Research and Communications class my junior year. She made everything we learned applicable to real life and I took a lot of useful skills away from the course. For example, we were discussing what it takes to arrange for a prominent person to speak somewhere. She asked us all to write a letter we thought would persuade somebody to come to campus. Then, she chose my proposal to Lt. Governor Mary Fallin. By the time the course was over, I had been an event coordinator for Fallin's actual visit to campus. I will use that as an example of practical learning the rest of my life.

In 1992, your sixth-grade choir sang with DuSharme Carter (who was Miss OCU and Miss Oklahoma) at the Miss Claremore competition. Have you had the opportunity to tell her she inspired you?

No. I would love to, and hope to get the chance. I think it's important for her to know,

now that I'm in her shoes, I fully understand that even thirty seconds spent with children can make an enormous difference in their lives. It made a big impression on me that, here she was, Miss Oklahoma, yet she wasn't too busy to interact with a bunch of sixth graders. It's a responsibility I take very seriously. I know if I motivated somebody to achieve a difficult life goal, it would mean so much to me to hear from them about it.

Have your attitudes about the pageant system changed over the years?

Well, I know the substance, not just the perceptions. I think I was always interested in it, if just out of practicality. I've gotten over \$80,000 in scholarships. That's nothing to sneeze at.

The best thing is my friends still treat me the same as ever. Yes, I'm Miss Oklahoma, but with them I'm also just Kelley. I don't get the feeling any of my friends find me less approachable now, which is great. Brooke Haley, my roommate at OCU and really good friend, would tell you I'm still just one of the girls.

“That’s the first thing my mom and I talked about after I won. ‘I get to have my picture on that wall at OCU!’”


It's a little awesome to think only about four thousand women have ever gone to the Miss America Pageant. It's still surreal to me that I'm driving the organization's car and living in the apartment and, in September, will go to Atlantic City. I'm sure it will hit me in August, when I don't fall into my regular OCU routine of moving in and taking classes.

You talked about substance versus perception. Do you mean those who call the pageant system sexist or exploitative?

I think it's important for all contestants to say this is so much more than just a pageant. I mean, yes, it *is* a pageant, but you get intangibles you wouldn't gain anywhere else as a twenty-two year old woman. The amount of confidence it builds is amazing. You have to learn public speaking skills and effective interviewing. It's pretty important to know how to present yourself to other people regardless of what you do.

What would you like to say to the OCU family?

First, thanks to whoever decided to give Miss Oklahoma a full tuition scholarship. The university recruits young, driven, intelligent women, who then get the best education possible.

Second, people should know OCU students really appreciate the academic quality produced by one-on-one attention from professors. I think the university has the most prepared, confident, and appreciative students because of that.

Our largest annual donor, providing over \$750,000 in donations each year, is the Oklahoma Episcopal area of the United Methodist Church. Oklahoma City University is blessed with more support from a statewide conference than any other Methodist-affiliated university in the nation.

Oklahoma City Community Foundation

The Oklahoma City Community Foundation provides valuable annual support through endowed funds given on behalf of Oklahoma City University. In FY2002-03, this amounted to \$214,079.

Capital Gifts

FY2002-03 was a banner year for capital improvement donations:

- Drs. Herman and LaDonna Meinders are the sole funders of the new \$20 million Meinders School of Business building.
- Dr. Wanda L. Bass has given \$20 million toward construction of a music center, which should be completed within the next two years. It will more than double the space available for the School of Music.
- Gifts from the families of Marjorie J. Norick and Frances Norick Lilly, included \$1.2 million to expand the Norick Art Center to allow space for graphic art and photography programs.
- Dr. Ann Lacy added another million dollars to her planned gift to help the university fund renovation of the former United Methodist Conference office building into the Lacy Visitor and Admissions Center.

She also gave the school 105 Steinway pianos, worth \$2.1 million, establishing it as an all-Steinway institution with the largest single order in the 149-year history of Steinway & Sons. The 69,000-square-foot music center will stand adjacent to the existing Kirkpatrick Fine Arts Center and nearly double the size of the School of Music.

UNITED METHODIST YOUTH DAY 2003

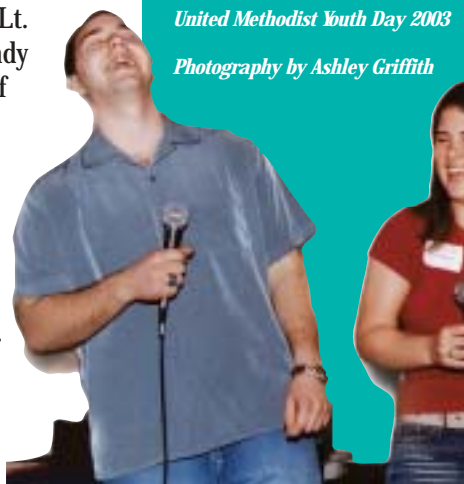

***James J. Backus, '98 honorary
Doctor of Arts Management***

Backus worked with the Maryland State Arts Council from 1969 to 1976 and from 1986 to 2001, twice serving as executive director. Maryland ranked seventh nationally in per capita arts funding by the end of his career. He had national influence through service as co-chair of the National Endowment for the Arts Music Advisory Panel, executive board member of the National Assembly of State Arts Agencies, and board member of National Public Radio, the Kennedy Center, the Mid-Atlantic Arts Foundation, and the Writer's Center.

School of American Dance and Arts Management Dean John Bedford worked with Backus as deputy director during his first term at the Maryland State Arts Council: "In Maryland, I began arts management instruction programs to help arts organizations to better utilize their limited resources. Jim was one of my major arts administration mentors and had a profound influence on my career and my approaches to program development, staff development, and management philosophy and style. I

have often told the students I have mentored that Jim was their 'arts management grandfather.' He was very proud of the accomplishments of the School of American Dance and Arts Management and the recognition of his career by OCU through the honorary doctorate."
