

# OKCU VPN Instructions

To begin, visit <https://ocu-portal.okcu.edu> from your home computer. You will be presented with a login screen that looks similar to the image below, on the left.

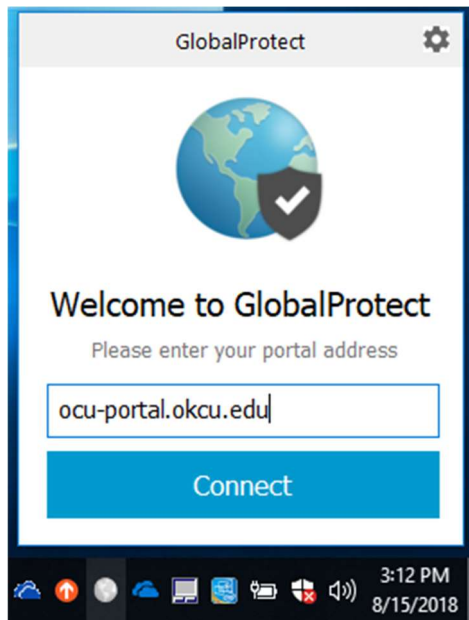


The login to this system is your network username and password: the same credentials used for signing into your computer or BlueLink.

The next page will present you with a list of download options. It will look similar to the image on the right. Choose the option that best corresponds to your operating system.



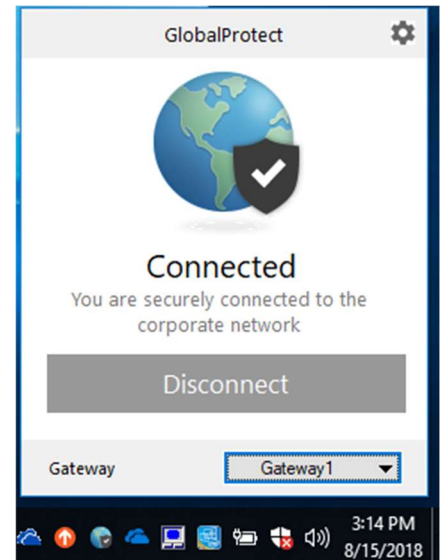
After downloading the client, install it as you would any normal program, accepting the default install location and allowing it to run on your computer.



After installation, you should see a “white globe” in your taskbar. Clicking this will launch the Global Protect client, shown at the left. Fill out the portal address as shown on the left:

If successful, the white globe icon will turn colorful and it will show “Connected”, as shown to the right.



You are now connected to the OKCU Network. To connect to your computer, use the “Remote Desktop Connection” program. It is installed by default on Windows (search for it in your start menu), or on Mac you will need to install it from the App Store.

Launch the application, and enter the name of your computer plus “.okcu.edu” in the connection field, as shown to the right.

It will prompt you for credentials. These are the same credentials used earlier, to connect to the VPN Global Protect client.
