

# Student Outcomes – Graduating Class of 2017

Class of 2017 includes graduates from July 1st, 2016 through June 30th, 2017

Data were collected from exit surveys at the time of graduation and follow-up surveys six months after graduation. Student Outcomes Surveys distributed six months after Spring graduation to all students graduating between July 1<sup>st</sup> 2016 and June 30<sup>th</sup> 2017. Outcomes from all sources were compiled to provide the following data. For those who provided multiple responses, the most recent data were used. Employment rates are based on the number with employment outcomes (based on [NACE definitions](#)) among those for whom data were available.

## Undergraduate Students

The total undergraduate class included 508 students. Outcomes were known for 307 students, giving us a knowledge rate of 60.43%.

## Masters students

All 283 students completing master's degrees were surveyed, outcomes were known for 156 of them yielding a knowledge rate of 55.12%.
