

Student Outcomes – Graduating Class of 2016

Class of 2016 includes graduates from July 1st, 2015 through June 30th, 2016

Data were collected from exit surveys at the time of Fall (for summer and Fall graduates) and Spring graduation, and Student Outcomes Surveys distributed six months after Spring graduation. Outcomes from all sources were compiled to provide the following data. Employment rates are based on the number with employment outcomes (based on NACES definitions) among those for whom data were available.

Undergraduate Students

The total undergraduate class included 562 students. Outcomes were known for 260 students, giving us a knowledge rate of 46.26%.

A total of 88 Masters students were surveyed, outcomes were known for 39 of them providing a knowledge rate of 44.32%.
