Kramer School of Nursing Admission Testing Procedures

General Information

The HESI exam will cover English (reading, grammar, and vocabulary), Science (biology, chemistry, and anatomy & physiology), and Math. Students must complete all 11 sections of the exam. A missing exam section will invalidate the score. KSN Applicants may take the HESI exam a maximum of two times; the highest cumulative score will be used. A minimum cumulative score of 75 will be required.

The time allotted to complete the exam is four hours. Resources are available for those who are interested in preparing for the exam, including HESI Admission Assessment Exam Review (4th Ed.) which may be ordered directly from Elsevier or your preferred retailer. Numerous other prep courses and practice questions are available online as well.

All applicants should refer to the KSN website for the most current exam dates and to these instructions for scheduling the HESI exam. - Ms. Calhoun will provide students the Payment ID and the HESI website.
- Students will notify Ms. Calhoun when fee is paid.
- Ms. Calhoun will then confirm payment and schedule a testing time.
- Students must bring a photo ID to gain access to the test.

Testing will occur alternate Saturdays, from 1-5pm, at Kramer School of Nursing. Dates are listed separately at the KSN website. Up to twenty-five will be scheduled on each test date. Results will be available on the Wednesday following the test. The score will be recorded on the student's admission application. Students who miss their scheduled exam will have a make-up session scheduled.

For those testing at an out-of-state Prometrics site, Ms. Calhoun will individually send instructions. Scores will be obtained in the same manner.

If you have already taken the HESI exam and achieved a minimum score of 75, please notify Ms. Calhoun and she will verify your score.
