The 2013 OCU Undergraduate Top Ten is a product of the Star Summit for Student Leadership, an annual planning event that brings together student leaders from across the campus for the purpose of building community, coordinating the student activity calendar for the coming academic year and to identify issues of campus improvement.

Top Ten Methodology:

In the weeks prior to the Star Summit for Student Leadership, student leaders invited the general undergraduate student body to ask questions about campus operations. These questions were organized into categories and presented to student attending the Star Summit. The Star Summit participants work in small groups to respond to the questions. These responses inspired the following list of action items. Top ten items are bolded and in rank order):

Culture

United Methodist heritage is under-appreciated

Academic

Investigate implementing a dead week

Final exams are weighted too heavy in some courses

Re-evaluate +/- system

Housing

Washers and dryers are often out of service and laundry is expensive

Summer housing rates too high for international students

Eliminate mold and improve air quality

Improve the consistency of RA's regarding room checks and upholding standards

Add WiFi to University Manor

Add quarter machine to University Manor

Star Card

Clarify how money and points work

Expand function to include residence hall exterior entrance and vending machines

Health Services

Where will it be relocated to accommodate new sorority?

Expand hours of operations to include weekends

Police/Parking

Clarify policies regarding weekend ticketing of parking lots

Tickets too expensive

Improve distribution plan by increasing amount of lots available to everyone

Clarify Contest Winner Parking – what contest?

Add more covered parking

Fitness Center

Expand facility – currently too small, overcrowded

Expand operations to 24 hours

Cafeteria

Expand dinner options: vegan bar, yogurt bar, salad tosser

Add healthy options – sodium and gluten-free
