Instructions for Gateway Education (BSN) Self-Guided Transcript Evaluation

The Self-Guided Transcript Evaluation Worksheet for Incoming Gateway Education (BSN) will provide a preliminary, unofficial evaluation of your college/university transcripts and help determine the program requirements which you have already completed.

A list of courses which have been approved for transfer, as well as the corresponding OCU course numbers and credit hours, can be found using the Transfer Evaluation Submission System (TESS) at <https://secure.okcu.edu/registrar/tess/Evaluated.aspx>.

If you do not see a course listed on the equivalency matrix, or your school is not available in the drop down menu, you may request to have courses evaluated by submitting course information to <https://secure.okcu.edu/registrar/tess>. Course descriptions from the catalog of the school where the course was taken are required. Typically, course evaluations may take up to two weeks, and perhaps longer during summer months. To receive an official transcript evaluation, please complete the OCU application found at <http://www.okcu.edu/admissions>. Transcripts must be mailed directly to OCU from every college or university in which you have enrolled, whether you completed coursework or not. Kramer School of Nursing will create an evaluation after all official transcripts have been received. Results of that evaluation will be emailed to the address you provide.
