

BILL HUTTON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

For Graduate Study in Business Administration



Sonic Corporation executives created the Bill Hutton Endowed Memorial Scholarship in 1992 as a tribute to Bill Hutton, a valued colleague. While studying for his MBA, Hutton served as Senior Director of field marketing for Sonic Corporation. He completed his degree in 1982. This scholarship assists students, like Hutton, who pursue an MBA while working.

The scholarship is designated for:

- ❖ MBA students who are US Citizens
- ❖ Working 25 or more hours per week while earning their degree
- ❖ Preference is given to applicants who have some work experience, are trying to improve their position through higher education, and are likely to remain in the Oklahoma business community.
- ❖ While financial need is not an absolute criterion, applicants should demonstrate some element of need to meet tuition expenses.

A scholarship committee, which includes Carol Hutton Cochran, MSB representatives and a past scholarship recipient, reviews applications and conducts personal interviews with selected scholarship finalists. *Scholarship awards are granted for a maximum of 18 hours of tuition credit per academic year. Recipients must maintain a 3.0 grade point average to continue the scholarship the following year.*

Monday, February 26, 2018, is the application deadline for the next scholarship award.

Recipients will be announced at the annual Meinders School of Business Honors Convocation. Scholarship proceeds will be available for use in the Summer nine-week cycle for the accelerated MBA program or Summer I for students taking courses on campus.
